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how do we find the right word for the job where does that word come from why do we spell it like that and how do we know what it means words are all around us we use them every day to communicate our joys fears hopes opinions wishes and demands but we don't often

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explores the processes of monolingual language development in pre school children following an overview of child bilingualism this book looks at the influence of the child s family environment and the factors which predict the language use of the child
