of human rights and freedoms the british mandatory legislation includes security legislation such as the defence emergency regulations 1945 which empowers military commanders as well as the entirely executive branch of the government to impose severe restrictions on fundamental rights and freedoms despite the enactment of two basic laws on human rights in 1992 many areas such as personal freedom freedom of speech and the right of association and assembly are still regulated mainly by british colonial legislation that was never revoked after the establishment of the state of israel since 1948 a permanent state of emergency is in force in israel this entitles the government to apply the inherited british mandatory security legislation as well as the own by the israeli parliament enacted emergency regulations israel s legal system has been built upon the duality of secular and religious law a concept that was inherited from the ottoman millet tradition first by the british mandatory government and then by the state of israel this study also includes important laws and supreme court judgments concerning civil and political rights that relate directly or indirectly to the territories occupied by israel in the course of the war in june 1967
